

GARDEN SONG White Wine 2022

Grape Varietals: 80% Vermentino & 20% Grenache Blanc (30hl/ha)

Vineyards & Age of Vines: Vielle Vigne 2019 & Les Crouzettes 2012 – Cruscades

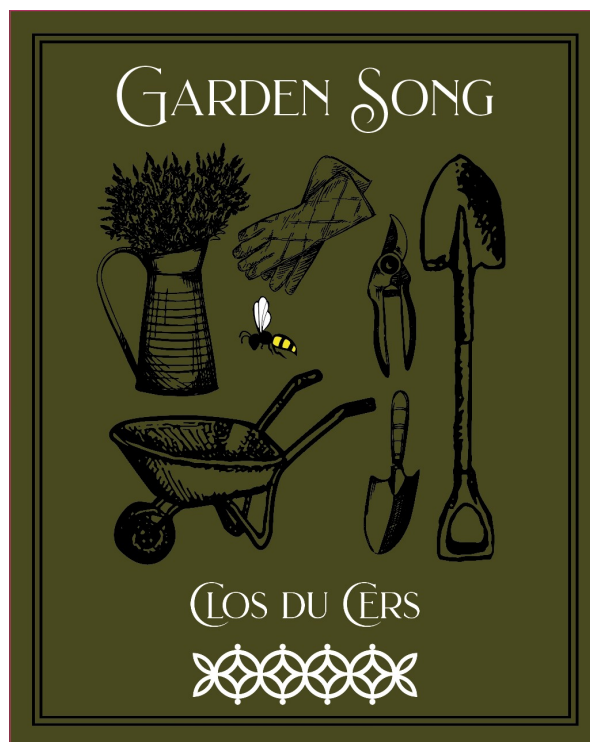
Terroir: Clay & Quaternary alluvial

Training method: Trellising - Cordon de Royat and Gobelet Pruning

Harvest: Hand harvested, September 2022

Vinification: Destemming by gravity, direct press, fermentation at low temperature in fiber tanks

ABV: 13.5%



NOTES FROM THE WINEGROWERS:

We got married in 2019 at the historic Abbaye de Fontfroide and instead of accepting gifts we asked our guests to aid in the plantation of our Vermentino (Rolle). With their generosity we have one hectare of the best white wine grape to plunge its roots into our Mediterranean soil. The name “Garden Song” is in reference to the great folk song by David Mallett, an Uncle, and it honors our “green thumb” family.

2022 was the first harvest for this vineyard. We had spring rains and a hot summer. The drought did not affect the harvest, it just gave us a beautiful aromatic and ripe fruit. We vinified by gravity and only added 3g/hl of sulfites when bottling.

This white wine retains its refreshing acidity while offering a complex bouquet of ripe stone fruits and juicy grapefruit. It stays with you a while, lingering on the tongue. We suggest you enjoy this cuvée with a fresh linguine with and homemade pesto sauce. Serve at 10°C.
